Call to Order/Introductions

We have information on the company who supplied the existing equipment but are open to finding new companies who may be more competitive.

Fundraising will look different this year. Trivia Night has been cancelled as we are not sure when we'll be able to gather in large groups again. The apparel sale is staying as is. We will wait to see what decisions the distinct makes for future fundraising. We are going ahead with the teacher holiday Scrip program this year. Teachers get a card with the names of the families who donated towards their gift, individual amounts donated are not listed. Information will go out early to mid-November.

Vice President's Report - Melissa Samuels

The PTO website has been updated. To find the website, you can just google Leonardo da Vinci School for Gifted Learners to find the weebly website. Where and when the PTO meetings occur is listed on the home page. Newsletters will be updated monthly and posted in the News section. You can also find "Teacher's Favorite Things" on the website. Helen went over current financial figures and the annual budget for the 2020-2021 school year. The entire breakdown can be found on the PTO website. Our fundraiser last year was 30% higher than the year prior. There are not a lot of expenses this year so the budget is minimal for many items. Funds were increased for extracurricular support and enrichment, staff support, and the Playground Expansion Project. Once a committee is formed and bids are in for the Playground Expansion Project, we will set a budget for that.

School is accountable when using school virtual communication accounts, so we are looking into finding parent volunteers on Wednesdays to be Zoom facilitators during social Zoom time for free discussion, not necessarily on an academic subject. Please ask your child to turn their cameras on during class. 6-8 grade students, in particular, are having a difficult time leaving their cameras on.
