Leonardo da Vinci School PTO Meeting Minutes May 14th, 2019 Attendance-

Call to order- Marisa Hanson called the meeting to order at 6:30pm

President – Marisa Hanson confirmed that she would be stepping down as President of the PTO Board due to her family's decision to attend school in their home district. The PTO by-laws were discussed and it was stated that a vote would occur later in the meeting to fill the PTO Board Treasurer position.

Vice President Report-Mary Rupp reviewed future fundraising plans and other PTO activities.

- The Chipotle fundraiser went well. However, in the future we will request a day other than a Monday, if possible.
- Panera Bread-Oneida St will have our second fundraiser on Wednesday, June 5th from 4-8pm. Please show flier in order for us to receive the donation from the restaurant.
- The 2nd Annual Trivia Night will be held on Thursday, 2/20/20!

Treasurer Report- Checking account balance of \$13,710.56 and savings account balance of \$18,104.03. Total balance of \$31,814.59.

- The final Trivia Night numbers have been calculated. Total revenue was \$10,244, total expenses were \$2172 and there was a net profit of \$8062. Registrations made up 36% of the revenue, Live Auction 34%, Games/Raffles were 22% and Sponsorship was 7%.
- In terms of financial transparency, it was explained that all PTO expenditures could be found on the PTO website under the financial section in the Treasurer's Report . Any questions regarding the PTO finances can be directed to the board.
- School Apparel sales during the Spring Concert brought in \$637.
- Sue Soleski gave details regarding the costs of the End of the Year Carnival. There will be many craft opportunities, concessions and other fun activities. A bounce house will be rented and the owner has generously donated the use of the generator. Students will use their Leader Loot in order to participate in activities and purchase concessions. The PTO approved the fund request of \$1488.36.

Staff Representative Report-Allison Hockers reported that the faculty and staff very much appreciated this year's teacher appreciation activities. She also reported that the final total for this year's Pi Day Race was \$21,000, which brings the total funds raised to \$83,000.

Lisa Knuth reported that 40 Kwik Trip cards were purchased as gifts for Teacher Appreciation Week. The majority of the Holiday Scrip has been used, Lisa will be following up on the Scrip money that has not been used.

Board Member and Chair Positions-Updates were given regarding the open Board and Chair Positions

• Helen Vande Hei submitted her bio for the open Treasurer position for the PTO Board. Her nomination was approved and the Board moved to confirm her election. Helen will be begin on 6/11/19. She will be finishing out the current Treasurer's term as stated in the by-laws.

- Hind Gautam has been confirmed as the new Fundraising Chair. She will also be co-chairing the Marcus Theater fundraiser with Leslie Vogel.
- Katie Houle has expressed interest as the Apparel co-chair with Margarita Johnson. She will meet with the PTO Board and Margarita to see if it's a good fit.
- A committee will be formed for Trivia Night. Heather Stefaniak will continue to be the chair.
- Tiffany Bowles will be stepping down as PTO Board Member. This position does have voting privileges. Parents will be asked to submit their bios over summer break.

New Business-The committee reminded the group that all ideas for future meetings are welcomed. If parents do not feel comfortable talking during meetings, they're most welcome to email the PTO Board.

The possibility of apparel sales being strictly online is being discussed and reviewed. The main purpose of the apparel sales is to increase and encourage school spirit. However, it is a very labor intensive program and could be streamlined by focusing on online sales. We are currently looking to liquidate current in stock items and move solely to online sales. A Sign Up Genius will be sent out for an apparel booth sale during placement testing on 6/17/19.

Open Table Discussion

The remainder of the meeting was an open forum. Various ideas regarding apparel were discussed such as new products and options to purchase higher end products. A survey will be sent out asking families and students if they would be interested in researching pricing for high quality items.

It was suggested that the PTO sell DVDs of school performances. However, this is not possible due to privacy restrictions.

Chess Club continues to go well. Various options are being looked into in order to provide more hands on teaching to the chess club members.
