Leonardo da Vinci School PTO Meeting Minutes January 21st, 2020

Call to order- Mary Rupp, President, called the meeting to order at 6:32pm

President's Report- Mary Rupp notified the members present that Helen Vande Hei, Treasurer, would be interested in remaining on the board as Treasurer for the next term beginning October 2020. However, the President, Vice President and Secretary positions would be open. These are for 2 year terms. It is vital that positions are filled in order for the supports that the PTO provides the school continue. If interested in learning more, members were encouraged to contact the PTO Board.

- Members were asked to speak about PTO to their fellow LdV parent friends in order to increase awareness and attendance.
- The Marcus Theatre Ticket Fundraiser will begin March 24th, 2020. The last fundraiser raised around \$2300. This will be Leslie Vogel's last fundraiser with LdV, Hind Gatum will be taking lead in the future.
- Noodles and Co. will be hosting a fundraiser on January 22nd with 30% of their sales being donated to the PTO. February 4th will be the next fundraiser at Panera Bread.

VP Report- Phuong Hudson, Vice President, informed the members that a Special Someone Dance will be held most likely on April 3rd at the school. The dance will be for all Kindergarten-3rd graders. Each student can bring one special adult in their life. The cut off is 3rd grade due to space limitations. Also, 4th graders have the Madison Field Trip and 5th graders organize Pi Day. More information to follow in the next coming months.

Secretary Report-Lisa Hansen, Secretary, Melissa Samuels, LdV Parent, will present information about a possible LEGO club at the February meeting. Melissa is willing to coordinate with other volunteers the details of organizing a LEGO club, however, volunteer involvement is necessary. Please contact the PTO Board if interested.

Treasurer Report- The Checking account balance of \$18,076.08 and savings account balance of \$14,114.89. Total balance of \$32,190.97.

Helen Vande Hei informed the members that she has been having issues with Fox Communities Credit Union in regards to the PTO accounts. The credit union does not utilize electronic banking and their systems have been inefficient. The group was asked if there were any objections to transferring the PTO accounts to another bank and there were none. Also, Tammy VanDyke, LdV Principal, was asked if the district would have any bank preference and she said the district did not.

Publicity Chair-Roxanne Denneau has taken lead on all LdV PTO publicity efforts. She was recognized by the board as doing a fantastic job posting information on Instagram and Facebook. If there are any events that need to be shared through social media, please contact Roxanne.

Staff Representative Report-Allison Hockers reported that staff were very grateful for the generosity from the Holiday Scrip.

The organizing for the annual Pi Day 5k is underway. The new committee of the 5th graders are very excited about this year's run! The event will be on 3/7 in order to guarantee a t-shirt please register by 2/10/20.

Staff Appreciation- Lisa Knuth, PTO Board Member, reported that over \$10k was raised for this school year's Holiday Scrip program. The vast majority of the funds raised have been redeemed by teachers.

Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held on 2/27, 3/3 and 3/6. As in the past, a Sign-Up Genius will be sent out to families in order to volunteer to provide food and snacks. The PTO will also be sponsoring a lunch on the 3/6 conference day. Lisa reported that restaurants that provide options, such as make your own tacos, remain the favorite type of meal for faculty and staff since they provide a wide variety of food options for various dietary needs.

Trivia Night-Heather Stefaniak, Trivia Night Chair, reported that the plans are almost finalized for the 2nd annual LdV Trivia Night. This year's event will be held at Green Bay Distillery.

- A new feature will be the opportunity to participate in a special event hosted by LdV families. Events include a Chinese New Year Party and beer tasting with Zambaldi Beer. Additional opportunities are being finalized.
- Volunteers are still needed for the night (judges and 50/50 raffle).
- The committee is continuing to look for event sponsors. Please contact Heather or the PTO Board if additional information is needed regarding sponsorships.

Apparel-The next online apparel sale will be from February 27th-March 12th. Katie Houle, Apparel Cochair, reported that she has been working with our contact on possible new designs. Also, a letter will be sent to new students once placement testing is scheduled regarding online sales during the summer, with the plan for the families to pick up at Back-to-School Night.

Chess Club-Angela Whipp, Chess Club Coordinator, reported that the Chess Club Tournament hosted at LdV was very successful. Thirteen teams for a total of 66 students from all over the state participated. Concession stand sales went smoothly, however, next year additional pizza will have to be purchased. Also, parents filled all volunteer needs.

The LdV teams placed 1st in the K-5 and 6-8 categories!

Miscellaneous-Phuong informed the members that she was contacted by the after school program from First Preschool. They are located across the street from LdV and have provided after school programs to our students in the past. They have a couple spots available for children who would appreciate a quieter and relaxing program.

Kurt Pedersen stated that he was looking into beginning a Facebook/Meet Up group for LdV families in order to make it easier to form more social connections. He will keep us all posted.
